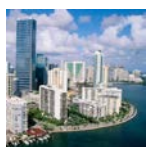
While our Cuban counterparts in Havana unexpectedly canceled the conference forty-five days before its scheduled date, we have rapidly and effectively overcome this setback.

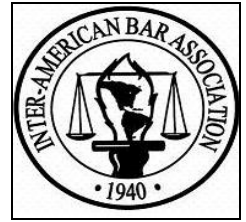

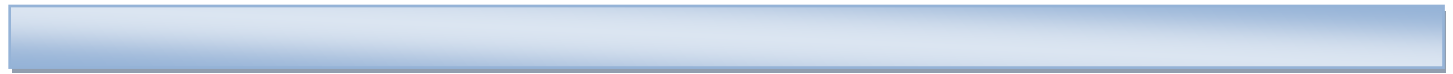
